FIRE REGULATIONS PROHIBIT 'OPEN FIRES' IN THE PARK

POOL REGULATIONS

1. All swimmers shall take a shower using warm water and soap and shall thoroughly rinse off all soap before entering or re-entering the pool area.
2. No person infected with a communicable disease or having open sores on his or her body shall enter the pool.
3. No person shall bring a glass container onto the deck or into the pool.
4. Alcoholic beverages and food are not permitted on the deck or the pool area.
5. Smoking is not permitted on the deck or pool area.
6. No person shall pollute the water in the pool in any manner. Spitting, spouting of water and blowing the nose in the pool or on the deck are prohibited.
7. No person shall engage in running, pushing of others or boisterous play in or about the pool.
8. Ratio of lifeguards to swimmers must be maintained as per Regulation 565 and is based on a ratio of 1 to 30. When this ratio is exceeded, the lifeguard will ask those wishing to enter the pool area to form a line. The lifeguard will then ask all those that are in the pool to leave the pool area and join the end of the line for re-entry.
9. The nearest emergency telephone is located at the Pool House.
10. Children under the age of 10 years who are non-swimmers must be accompanied by a parent or guardian who is at least 12 years of age and responsible for their direct supervision.
11. Children under the age of 10 who are swimmers (able to demonstrate comfort in the water and pass the facility swim test) may be admitted to the swimming pool unaccompanied.
12. Children under the age of 6 years may not be admitted to the swimming pool unless they are accompanied by a parent or guardian who is responsible for their direct supervision, with a maximum of two children for each parent or guardian.

THE ABOVE REGULATIONS ARE FOR YOUR HEALTH AND SAFETY; PLEASE OBEY THEM
AND THE LIFEGUARD AT ALL TIMES!
IF YOU DISOBEY ANY OF THESE RULES, YOU MAY BE BANNED FROM THE PARK.
